Petition title

Reducing the risk of ovarian cancer

Petition summary

Calling on the Scottish Parliament to urge the Scottish Government to raise public awareness:

- of the importance of the CA125 blood test to help detect ovarian cancer; and
- that endometriosis can cause an increased risk of ovarian cancer.

Action taken to resolve issues of concern before submitting the petition

I have written to Nicola Sturgeon and Hannah Bardell.

Petition background information

I was diagnosed with ovarian cancer in November 2016. Further genetic testing showed the likely cause of my cancer was endometriosis. A simple blood test at the outset by my GP could have highlighted possible ovarian cancer. A screening programme could reduce many incidents of ovarian cancer.

A CA125 test measures the amount of the protein CA125 in blood. In some cases, a CA125 test may be used to look for early signs of ovarian cancer in people with a very high risk of the disease.
