#### PE1521: No More Page 3 in the Scottish Sun and Scottish Parliament

Thank you for your letter of 18 June 2014 about the above petition and please accept my apology for the delay in replying to you.

Your Committee has asked for my comments on the petitioners' request that the Scottish Parliament cease to stock or sell the Scottish Sun while it retains the Page 3 feature and the petitioners argue this is contrary to the Parliament's Equalities Framework. Your Committee has also asked for details of how many copies of this publication are stocked and sold and the locations the publication is displayed. This information, together with details of other newspapers is enclosed with this letter.

I have discussed your request with the SPCB.

The Corporate Body recognises the strength of feeling on this petition and notes that the Parliament has debated the wider issue of Page 3 by way of a Member's debate in November last year which garnered cross party support.

In terms of the availability of the Scottish Sun, two copies are supplied to the Parliament each day for sale at the coffee bar in the Garden Lobby, along with the other newspapers outlined in the enclosure to this letter. In addition, two reference copies of the Sun are also available to Members in the Queensberry House lounge and a further copy is available to MSPs in SPICe (our in-house information service). All of these areas are within private parts of the building. No newspapers are sold in parts of the building that are readily accessed by the public.

While the SPCB recognises the strength of feeling around Page 3, the Corporate Body is mindful that the Parliament should also recognise the right of individuals - and newspapers - to operate freely under the law.

Within that the SPCB considers it important, that Members and those working in the Parliament have the right to decide whether or not to purchase or read this publication, or indeed any other that is available for sale or viewing.

For those reasons the Corporate Body has no plan at present to prohibit the sale or availability of this paper at Holyrood

The SPCB notes the point made by the petitioners that the stocking of this publication is contrary to the Parliament's Equalities Framework. The SPCB takes very seriously the provisions made within this framework and considers that there would only be a breach if the stocking or sale of the publication amounted to sexual harassment under the Equality Act 2010. To date there has been no case law which challenges the stocking or selling of the Sun newspaper within any workplace in Scotland or the wider UK.

The Corporate Body will, of course, keep the position under review and take note in particular of any legal developments or any position adopted by the Parliament itself.
