

**PUBLIC PETITIONS COMMITTEE CONSIDERATION OF PE1577
QUESTIONS/ISSUES ARISING FROM COMMITTEE MEETINGS**

THURSDAY 9 NOVEMBER 2017

Minister for Public Health and Sport -

- The Committee agreed to write to the Scottish Government to ask why there has been no further engagement with the petitioner since the beginning of 2017, despite the commitment to work with the petitioner and to urge the Scottish Government to engage with the petitioner as soon as possible.

The National Institute for Health and Care Excellence –

- Through correspondence received from the Scottish Government, the Committee understands that the National Institute for Health and Care Excellence is currently developing guidance for the management and treatment of cerebral palsy in adults which will be published in 2019.
- The Committee agreed to write to NICE to clarify what opportunity there may be for the petitioner, or others with an interest in the issue of services for adults with cerebral palsy, to contribute to the work on developing the guidance.

THURSDAY 25 MAY 2017

Scottish Government –

- To ask the Scottish Government for the findings from the pilot programme and the mapping exercise.
- To ask the Scottish Government's further assessment of the way forward that is informed by that work, including whether the Scottish Government is minded to produce national guidance for health boards and the timeframe for doing so.

THURSDAY 22 DECEMBER 2016

The Committee agreed to invite the Minister for Public Health and Sport to give evidence at a future meeting.
